CALLING ALL ARTISTS!

Metro Vancouver and the Minnehada Park Association are pleased to host its 5th Annual Art in the Park Festival at Minnehada Regional Park. We are seeking enthusiastic artists to participate in a two day art festival and exhibition that offers visual arts, live music, roving performers, arts and crafts workshops, a children's area and the Creative Cafe. This is an opportunity for artists from different origins and disciplines to meet and share their passion, network with the public, colleagues and friends.



Requirements and Criteria

Art sales are welcomed as by-products of this exhibition and not as the sole purpose. There is a minimal exhibitor fee; however, no percentage of the artists' sales is retained by the organizers. Credit card payment processing stations are available on-site.

Each artist is required to pay applicable fees and submit a biography (max. 100 words), a head shot for the event guide and two to three photos of your artwork as part of your application package. The jury panel selects qualified candidates and will notify each artist of their final decision by letter. All cheques will be held until after jurying and if your application is not accepted; your cheque will be destroyed.

Applicants will be juried relative to the integrity, originality, level of craftsmanship and artistic merit of their artwork. Applicants will also be judged relative to the diversity of artwork from other participants. Mass-produced goods of any kind (cards, imported bags and clothing, jewellery, and soap and bath products) are not accepted as we encourage applicants to produce their own artwork.
